It is meant for beginners who must buy all the supplies for a class. Once the person has started taking the beginning classes and has purchased the supplies, they fill out a form, attach the receipt, have the teacher sign the form and then they will be reimbursed for 50% of the cost of the supplies up to \$50.

Thanks to all of you who filled out our survey. Jim Hall, our webmaster, and Vicki Bengelut, our secretary, are working on simplifying the way we communicate with our members to prevent duplication of effort and provide an ease of access to the information.

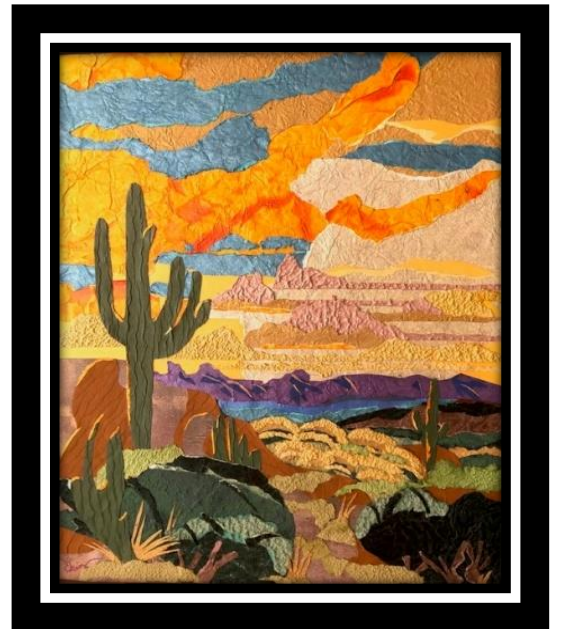
